



History

Time line of the Tudors

Explore Tudor fashion through pictures and identify different pieces of Tudor clothing.

Investigate the foods which Tudor people ate and find out about the new foods which were being brought to England at the time.

Discover the punishments given to criminals during Tudor times and who was in charge of law and order. Explore the illnesses and diseases that were common in Tudor times and discover how they were treated.

Science

Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.

Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C).
Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.


