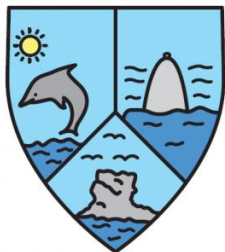


Rowan Class History - Events within Living Memory

Timeline-a picture of a line that represents a period of time, on which important events are marked	The world and how people live have changed over time but some things have remained the same.
Past-already happened	We can learn about the past by talking to people and looking at pictures, photographs and artefacts
Present-happening now	I have changed since I was a baby
Future-not happened yet, still to come	People invent things and this changes how people live their lives
History-the study of the past	You can order a set of events or objects and use a timeline to show when things happened
historical artefact- an object from the past that has been made by people	In the last 50 years the following were invented: DVD players, iPhones, the internet, Google and digital cameras
